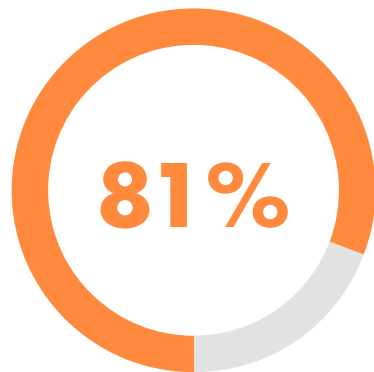


WHEN WE SAY “CLOUD”, WHAT DO WE REALLY MEAN?
